CHRIS' TIPS

Impact Position is critical for players to become solid ball strikers. If you watch the best players, if you watch my YouTube videos, and if you have taken a lesson from me than you know how much emphasis I put on the impact position. The knowledge of how to correctly strike a golf ball which is different than anything else you do is the single most important factor in becoming a good player.

Those who have learned these key ideas become good ball strikers for life. Most golfers think they have to work on their backswing position or some other thing to hit the ball well. The first thing a player must work on is the knowledge of how to strike a ball and then to train/ educate the hands to repeat this feeling over and over again. I had the privilege of spending a few days with legendary golf instructor Ben Doyle and learned first hand what is the correct way to strike a ball.

I take a personal interest in each one of my students to give them the best knowledge and tools for playing the game better. I strive to empower each student to improve and exceed their goals. I enjoy being a "coach" more than just being the guy that looks at your swing sometimes. I look forward to the opportunity to help you with your golf game.
