GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

- Thank you for coming! Spectating is a privilege.
- Please follow the spectator guidelines



- Reminder to not interfere with the players scoring. It is their responsibility.
- Must check-in with tournament staff before going on the course.
- Smoking is not allowed on the course by spectators or caddies.
- Alcohol is not allowed on the course by spectators or caddies

SPECTATOR RULES

- All SPECTATORS MUST CHECK-IN WITH TOURNAMENT STAFF BEFORE GOING ON THE **COURSE!**
 - We are happy to have parents at all of our FCG Tour Events. Here are some policies in place for you to follow:

- Parents/spectators <u>CAN</u> do the following:
 Walk on the cart path and watch your child play golf
 Carry an umbrella, food, drink, medicine, etc... for your child. If the competitor needs any of the following these can be obtained BETWEEN play of holes, not during play.
 Forecaddie and help your child and other players search for a golf ball

The following actions are <u>UNACCEPTABLE</u> from a parent/spectator: Verbally abusing or belittling players for any reason Yelling and/or cursing at players/officials/golf course staff Hand signals/gestures (These are considered advice!)

- · Interfering with players/officials/golf course staff while in the scoring area
- Giving rulings to juniors on the golf course (too often the information is incorrect)
- Interfering with any player's opportunity to compete fairly and fun while playing the game of golf

GOLF CARS AND PULL CARTS

- Due to the field size Spectators will not be allowed to rent a golf car at this event
 - There will be limited golf cars available for handicap spectators and those must be cleared with the Tournament Staff on site.
- Pull carts are allowed at all FCG Tour Events
 - Sycuan Resort has inventory of approximately 20 Pull Carts for Rent. This will be on a first come first serve basis
 - You can bring your own pull cart.

RANGE FINDERS

- Are allowed at all FCG Tour Events
- They cannot measure slope!



RANGE BALLS / PRACTICE AREAS

- Range will open at Sun Up at Sycuan and Steele Canyon Golf Club
- Please note you will need to share your range stall throughout the event
 - Please hit 3-4 balls and then rotate with someone else
 - All players will receive a small bucket of balls each day
 - Please be respectful of all players and share your spot!
- The range will be open after play and you can purchase balls with the course staff

PACE OF PLAY

- **Ready Golf** to be played at all times!
- 1st and 2nd Player to Hole Out in Each Group Must go To the Next Tee and Tee Off.
- Rules Officials and Marshals will have Red and Green Cards and Will Notify Players throughout the round if they are in Good Position or Behind.
- **9-Hole Pace of Play Check-Point**. If you receive a Green Card your group is in position. If you receive a Red Card that means you are behind your allotted time and need to catch up. Once behind all players must make an effort to catch up or will be subject to penalty.
 - Walking with Purpose All players to walk with intent to reach their ball
 - When looking for a lost ball Spectators should assist player looking for ball and other players should continue to play their shots.
- Players will be subject to penalty when out of position.

CADDIES FOR 8 AND UNDER

Caddies are allowed for all 8 and under division players ONLY. No other age division can have a caddy!

Official Notice to Caddies:

- Acceptable pace of play is no more than 60 seconds for first player to hit and 40 seconds for each player after. Pace of Play structure is on your scorecard. As a group you need to play guickly. Ready Golf at All Times
- Caddies are asked to help by keeping the pace of play moving. If your group falls out of position you will be subject to timing and penalties until you are back in position. See pace of play rules sheet.
- There will be zero tolerance for poor attitudes by any caddie or player during play.
- Please help your player be ready as soon as it is there turn to hit.

Important USGA Caddie Related Rules

Rule 14-2b states that in "making a stroke," a player shall not allow his caddie to position himself on or close to an extension of the line of play or the line of putt behind the ball. A caddie may position himself in this manner before the player commits to beginning his swing but must move away once the player is set to begin his swing. Failure to do so will result in a two-stroke penalty.

2. Rule 8-2b states that when a player's ball is on the putting green, the player or his caddie may before, but not during, the stroke, point out a line for putting, but in doing so the putting green shall not be touched. No mark shall be placed anywhere to indicate a line for putting. Violation of this rule will result in a two-stroke penalty.

3. Rule 17-3 states that the player's ball shall not strike the flagstick or attendant when the flagstick is attended or the flagstick is in the hole, unattended, or when the ball has been played from the putting green. Should this occur, the player is

assessed a two-stroke penalty, and the ball is played as it lies. **4.** Rule 8-1 states that a caddie is one who carries or handles a player's clubs during play and otherwise assists him in accordance with the rules. A player may only have one caddie at any given time. A caddie may be replaced or eliminated at any time by the player. No other person may offer advice or help to a player other than his caddie.
Always remember that a rules violation by the caddie is the same as if the player violated the rule. A caddie must be aware of the rules and assist his player in accordance with the rules. Rules officials are in place throughout the course to help

players when needed.

LUNCH

- All players age 11 to 18 will receive lunch at the Turn
- Pine Glen Players (10 and Under) will not receive a lunch
- There will be bottled water on the course for players but please come prepared with your own as well. Bottled water is for the players only.
- 15-18 Divisions Final Round Saturday
 - For those that make the cut there will be a buffet lunch served for you immediately following play during the awards ceremony. There will be no lunch given to you between 9's on the final day.

SCORING

- When you complete your round head immediately to the scoring area and calculate your scores with the Tournament Staff. Please stay in the scoring area until your scorecard is final.
- Steele Canyon Scoring Area will be located in the Banquet Room
- Sycuan Pine Glen Players Scoring Area will be 50 yards from the 18th green on Pine Glen
- Sycuan Oak and Willow Glen Scoring area is located in front of the Main Sycuan Pro Shop

AWARDS CEREMONY

- Awards Ceremony will be held immediately after the completion of each age division.
- A tie for 1st place will be settled by a sudden death playoff. All other place finishes will be decided by a card off.
- Also if there is a tie for the Callaway Junior World Exemption we will do a sudden death playoff too.
- Top 5 players in each age division will receive an award.
- All award winners will be asked to stay a few minutes for photographs and interviews.
